



## CUPE Social Services Bill 124 Campaign Member Unity Letter

Bill 124 was imposed by the Ontario Conservative's to freeze the wages of frontline public service workers. It trampled on workers' fundamental rights to freely collectively bargain. And it forced workers to accept a one per cent wage cap during a period of skyrocketing inflation.

The bill caused havoc on Ontario's public services. It was an insult to all union members while amounting to a meaningful wage cut for public sector workers. And it was deemed unconstitutional in 2024.

Since that time, the government has offered raises to workers from some sectors – while ignoring others.

Workers in social services cannot be ignored any longer. We will not be forgotten on the frontline.

I support CUPE Ontario's *Worth Fighting For* campaign and stand in solidarity with my bargaining unit – and with all CUPE locals – as we fight to make up what was taken from us by Bill 124.
